Volunteer Screening Coordinator Report 2020-2021

There was one card issued for adults volunteering with RCSCC Falkland, one card for NLCC VAdm Kingsmill, and one for the Branch. This is a decrease of four cards compared to last year when there were three cards issued for Falkland, three for Kingsmill, and one for the Branch. The COVID -19 pandemic, and no in-person activity, is the reason for the decrease in screening requests.

The Ottawa Police Service charges \$20.00 to process a PRC/VSC, compared to \$60.00 for an applicant who is not a volunteer. NLOB covers this charge for our applicants.

I usually submit the NL card request within a week of receiving the package from the member. Although the time to receive a card has varied due to lockdowns and working from home protocols, it is usually about a month.

Nadine Logan was appointed as Volunteer Screening Coordinator during the 2020 AGM, but due to COVID-19, we were not able to do a turnover. There was only one card processed from March to December and it made sense for me to do the paperwork. It is hoped that with a return to in-person activities that we will do a turnover of responsibilities by September.
