Volunteer Screening Coordinator Annual Report 2019-2020

There were three cards issued for adults volunteering with RCSCC Falkland, three cards for NLCC VAdm Kingsmill, and one for the Branch. This is a decrease of eight cards compared to last year when there were ten cards issued for Falkland, four for Kingsmill, and one for the Branch. The COVID -19 situation has affected the numbers as there were seven applications for the Branch that weren't received by me prior to the shutdown.

The Ottawa Police Service started charging \$20.00 to process a PRC/VSS this year. NLOB covers this charge for our applicants.

I usually submit the NL card request within a week of receiving the package from the member. The suspension of the Ontario Division of the NLC has made it easier to submit applications as I can now drop off packages at the NLC National Office. The turnaround time has remained constant, at about three weeks, as their Screening Coordinator resigned to go to a new job.
